Global Compliance plays a critical role in the successful execution of the firm's compliance mission. Our strong compliance culture comes from developing and maintaining program infrastructure that identifies, measures and monitors compliance with applicable laws, regulations and rules that govern our business globally.

The Compliance teams partner with our Legal, Risk and Audit businesses to provide expertise on regulatory compliance matters such as maintaining regulatory relationships; assessing, measuring and reporting on compliance related risks; monitoring and testing the adequacy of the firm's compliance control environment as well as training and raising awareness internally.

Each Compliance team partners with a line of business or corporate staff area. This way, they can quickly develop productive relationships that allow them to benefit the firm on a daily basis. There are also several independent Compliance teams. These are:

- **Global Financial Crimes and Corruption** covers both global and business aligned functions supporting the firm's Anti-Money Laundering, Sanction and Anti Corruption programs.
- Policies and Practices Group supports the Compliance Program and covers Policy, Training and Awareness, Risk Assessment, Monitoring, Testing and Management Reporting, Governance and Regulatory Management.
- **Global Privacy** supports the businesses and the technology risk team on matters related to privacy of information.
- **Disclosure of Interest (DOI)** aggregates J.P. Morgan's global positions of securities for different business lines. The team coordinates disclosure reports for jurisdictions with individual regulations.
- Personal Account Trading pre-clears, monitors and reports on employee share trading.
- Project Management Office and Technology provide internal support for Compliance projects and initiatives.
